House and Furniture

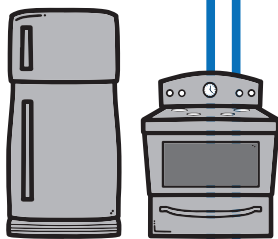


Overview:

Verbs we will be using and examples...

Hay - there is

Example: **Hay** un televisor en la sala.

There is a television in the living room.

Tiene - (it) has / **Tengo** - I have

Mi casa **tiene** diez ventanas.

My house has ten windows.

Tengo un sofá blanco.

I have a white couch.
